Welcome to the new newsletter that we circulate quarterly regarding Local Policing issues in Crewe.

Chief Inspector Andy Baker has returned as the Crewe Commander and will be known to many as he worked here a number of year ago.

Crewe policing team are dedicated to making Crewe a safer place to live, work and visit. Crewe has seen an increase in arrests by 4.7%, leading to us taking positive action for over 23% of all crime reported, a figure we are proud of and striving to improve .

We have also seen an increase in Stop & Searches by 33% in the last quatre, meaning that people who want to commit crime in Crewe are being relentlessly targeted on the streets making Crewe hostile for people intent on causing harm in our communities.

You Said: Keeping money safe from Fraud

We Did: Local beat officers attended the Co-operative bank in Crewe Town Centre to provide fraud prevention advice to service users. Educating about the risks of scams and utilising Action Fraud advice.

We Did: Attendance at South Cheshire College to deliver support and guidance to students about keeping safer during the evenings travelling from college and whilst out socialising. This included the promotion of the Hollie Guard application and Safer Streets.

We Did: There had been increased incidents of ASB at Leighton Brook Park, through partnership working between police, local council CCTV and education the suspects were identified, educated and issued ASB notices to deter them from reoffending.
