

### You Said, We Did

#### **Crewe Central**



**You Said:** Concerns have been raised by residents about Anti Social Behavior occurring on Bessemer Way.

**We Did:** Work with Housing providers and Cheshire East Council ASB team. Young people receive 'ASB alerts' for certain behaviours which is a letter home to their parents or carers. Local Officers also visit to discuss support we and other agencies can provide and give advice to families. If these steps do not reduce the behaviour then contracts can be created, through the Council and through Guinness housing, that highlight sanctions on behaviour to help protect the peace of the community for our residents.

#### **Crewe West**

**You Said:** Concerns were raised about youths gaining access to an unoccupied property on Buchan Grove Crewe. The property is in a very poor state of repair and youths have been gathering inside the derelict property, raising concerns about their safety and the amount of anti-social behavior caused by some of the individuals involved.

**We Did:** The address was added to the local beat team's patrol plan and extra patrols were carried out in and around the area. Several individuals were found inside the property and were spoken to and advised about their behavior. ASB alerts were submitted to our Partnerships Unit and parents were contacted and spoken to by the local PCSO. Enquiries will be undertaken to identify the property's owner and requests for boarding up will be made. Patrols of the area will continue to help ensure no further issues.

#### **Crewe St Barnabas**

**You Said:** The Residents Voice Survey results from the last 3 months showed that around 80% of respondents are concerned about drug use and dealing, and groups of people hanging around.

**We Did:** Work with partner agencies such as Cheshire East Council, Guinness Housing, and Change Grow Live, to help support vulnerable people in the community who are affected by substance abuse, or targeted by County Lines illegal drug gangs.
